The **2019 Census Update** allows users to run demographic reports for activity year **2019**.

The 2019 Census Data should be used for analysis of years of **2019 and forward**. This update includes the following:

- 2019 Distressed & Underserved Non-MSA Middle Income Geographies
- Limited Census update for US Territories (including Guam, American Samoa, Northern Mariana Islands and Virgin Islands)
 - Persons/Population
 - Households, count
 - Median Household Income
 - Families, Count
 - Median Family Income
 - Total Occupied Housing Units
 - Total Vacant Housing Units
 - Total Owner Occupied Housing Units
 - Total Rental Occupied Housing Units

- US Census
- US Census 2010 Island Area surveys
- Federal Financial Institution Examination Council (FFIEC)

Who should install

All CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* users.

Prerequisites

CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* 7.3 Service Pack 2 (SP2) is required to install this update. To check your CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* version, go to the program menu bar and select **Help > About CRA *Wiz***. Build numbers starting with "**73.2**" are acceptable.

Required permissions

This install updates the **USCensus** database, so both Windows read/write permissions and SQL Server database permissions are required. Wolters Kluwer recommends that the user running the install have both Windows admin and SQL Server admin login credentials.

Confirming Installation

To confirm installation of the 2019 Census Update, do the following:

1. Select the **2019** Activity Year under **Options > Year**.
2. In the **Create Areas** screen, select State: **01**
3. Confirm the first MSA listed reflects **11500 Anniston-Oxford, AL MSA**

Installation Instructions

To install the **2019 Census Data Update**, follow these steps:

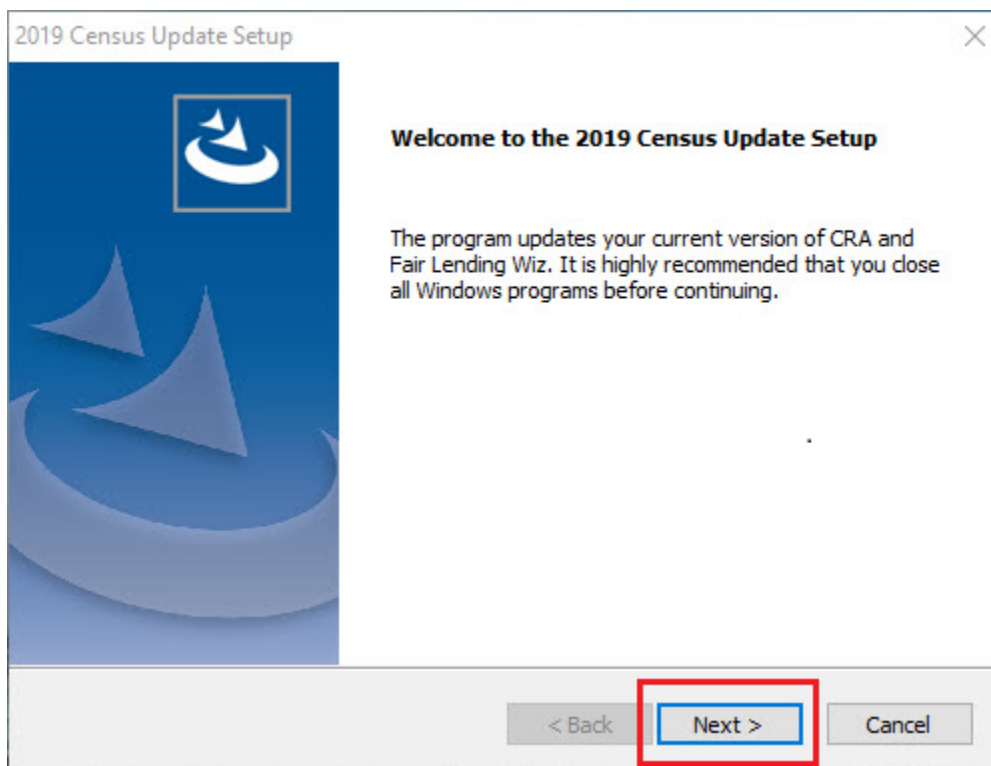
1. After downloading the update locally on your SQL Server, locate and double-click the **2019CensusDataUpdate** installation file.

The installer displays the **Welcome** screen.

2. Follow the directions for each of the following screens.

Welcome Screen


Click the **Next** button:

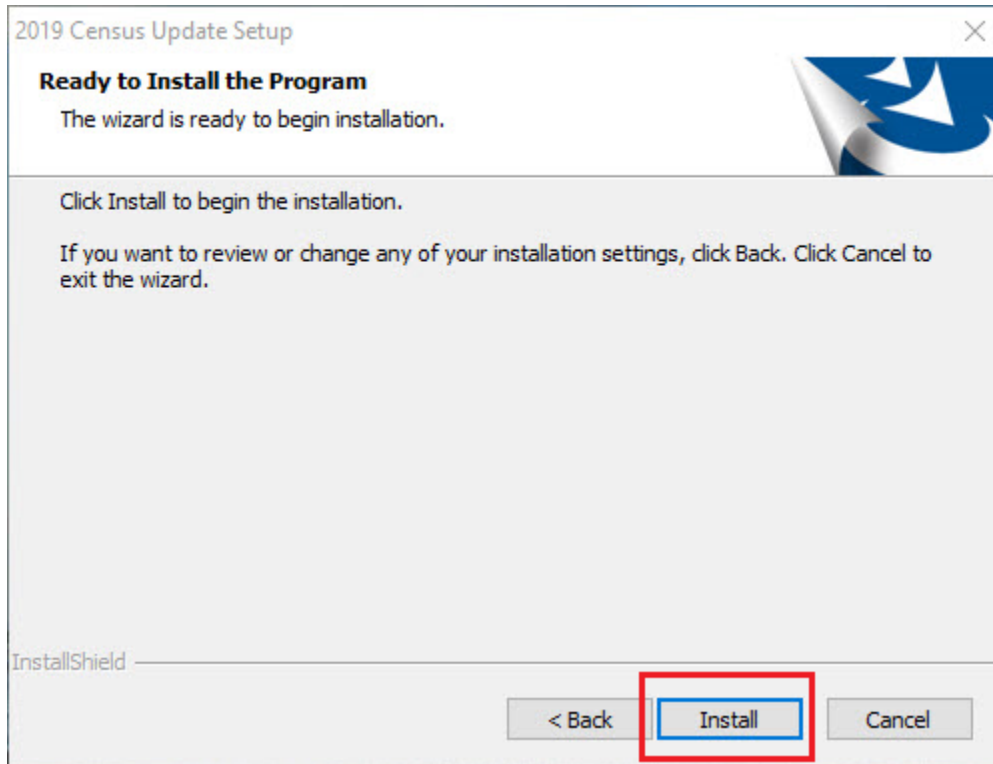
To configure login options, follow these steps:

Ready to Install Screen

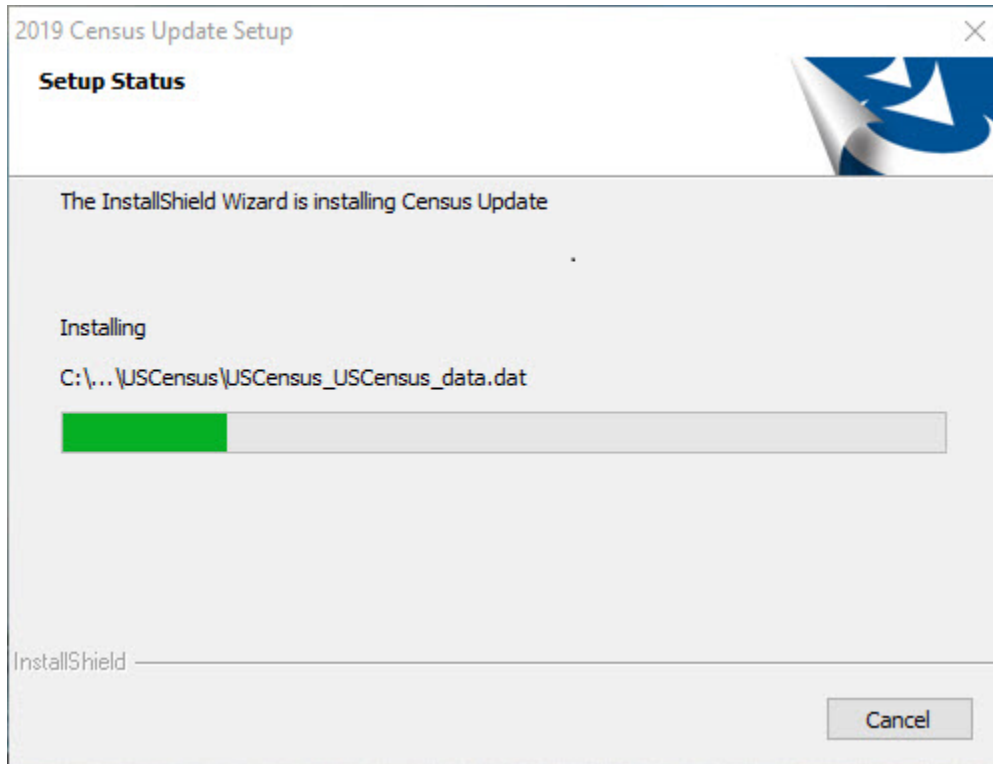
To begin installing the data sets, click the **Install** button:



The installer displays the **Setup Status** screen.

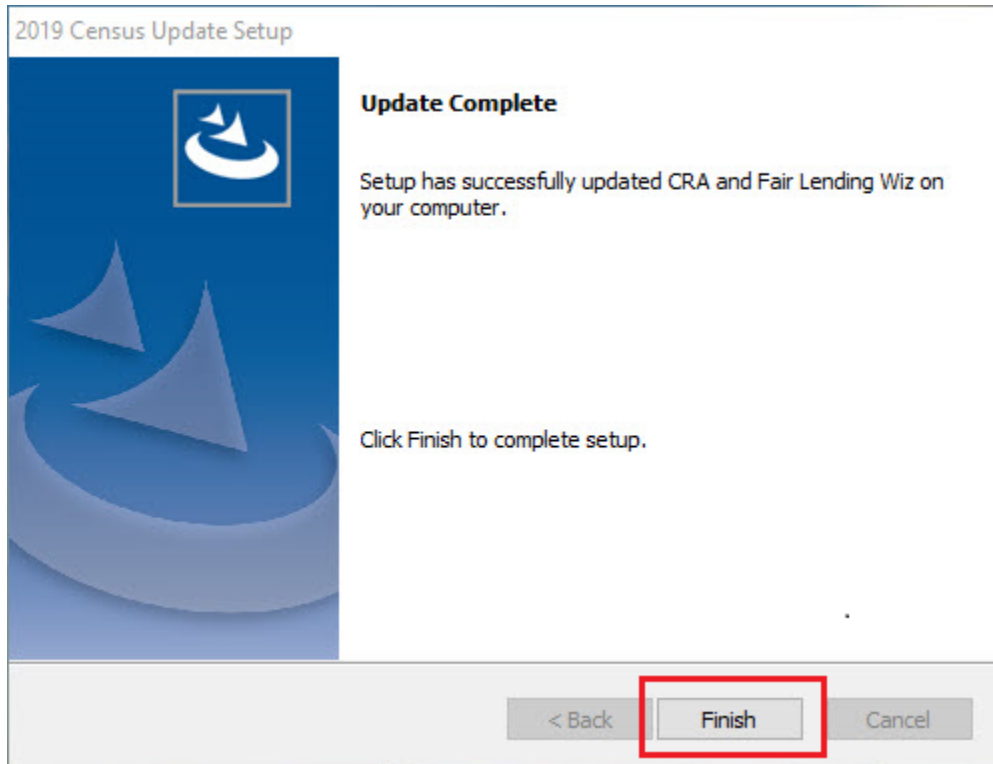
Setup Status Screen
