## 1 Overview

The 2022 ACS Census Update allows users to run demographic reports for activity year 2022.

This update includes the following:

- Includes the previously released 2022 Updated Median Family Income data
- 2022 Distressed & Underserved Non-MSA Middle Income Geographies\*
- 2016-2020 American Community Survey (ACS)

\*Note: Prior year distressed and underserved data will return "0" because 2022 is the first year that uses 2020 Census Tract boundaries.

#### 1.1 Data Source

- Federal Financial Institution Examination Council (FFIEC)
- US Census

#### 1.2 Who should install

All CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz users.

#### 1.3 Prerequisites

**CRA** *Wiz* and **Fair** Lending *Wiz* **7.5** Service Pack **1** (SP1) is required to install this update. To check your CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* version, go to the program menu bar and select **Help** > **About CRA Wiz**. Build numbers starting with "**75.10.xx**" are acceptable.

**Important!** This update can also be installed as part of the CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz 7.6 update.

#### 1.4 Required Permissions

This install updates the **USCensus** database, so both Windows read/write permissions and SQL Server database permissions are required. Wolters Kluwer recommends that the user running the install have both Windows admin and SQL Server admin login credentials.



#### 1.7 Confirming Installation


To confirm installation of the 2020 ACS Census Update, do the following:




1. Select the **2022** Activity Year under **Options** > **Year**:




2. In the **Create Areas** screen, right click on **State - AL (01)** and from the contextual menu, select **Show Demographics**:



#### The software displays the **Demographic Information** screen:




- 3. In the left-hand tool bar, expand the **GeoDemographics** tab.
- 4. Click the **Housing** button located at the bottom of the tool bar:

## 2 Installation Instructions

To install the **2020 ACS Census Data Update**, follow these steps:


1. After downloading the update locally on your SQL Server, locate and double-click the **2020ACSCensusDataUpdate** installation file.

The installer displays the **Welcome** screen.

2. Follow the directions for each of the following screens.

#### 2.1 Welcome Screen

Click the **Next** button:




The software displays the **SQL Server Login** screen.



#### 2.2 SQL Server Login Screen

Use this screen to enter the name of the **SQL Server** and to configure authentication options:



To configure login options, follow these steps:


- 1. In the **Database server that you are installing to:** field, enter the name of the SQL Server to which you are installing the data.
- 2. Choose one of the following authentication options:
  - Use Windows Authentication
  - Use SQL Server Authentication If you select this option, you must also enter your SQL Server account Login ID and Password in the provided fields.
- 3. Click the Next button.

The software displays the Ready to Install screen.

To begin installing the data sets, click the **Install** button:




The installer displays the **Setup Status** screen.



#### 2.4 Setup Status Screen


The **Setup Status** screen displays a progress bar that reports the progress of the installation:
