### 1 Overview

The **2023 FFIEC Median Family Income Update** allows users to run demographic reports for activity year **2023**. This update includes the following:

- 2023 FFIEC Median Family Income Update
- 2023 Distressed & Underserved Middle Income Non-MSA Census Tracts

#### 1.1 2023 FFIEC Median Family Income Update

On August 10<sup>th</sup> 2023, the FFIEC posted the 2023 Updated MSA Median Family Income (MFI) update. This annually adjusted MFI is based on the methodology defined by HUD and released by the FFIEC to be used in the Applicant Income calculation for the effective activity year 2023.

#### 1.2 Distressed and Underserved Geographies

On June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023, the FFIEC posted the **List of Distressed and Underserved Nonmetropolitan Middle-Income Geographies** for 2023. The 2023 list includes 2,911 Census Tracts. The FFIEC posted additional information regarding their sources and methodology <u>here</u>.

#### 1.3 Who should install?

All clients that use CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz should install this update.

#### 1.4 Where to install

The update should be installed on the CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz Server.

**Note**: There is **no** client update component to this release.

#### 1.5 Prerequisites

CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz 7.6 Event Scheduler and Filter Fix

#### 1.6 Required permissions

The installer uses an executable to write files to a drive of your choice. A Windows administrator account is recommended.

#### 1.7 Required disk free space and install times


Minimum 60 MB (megabytes) in approximately one (1) to two (2) minutes.

## 2 Installation Instructions

To install the 2023 FFIEC Median Family Income Update, do the following:


1. Run the 2023FFIECMedianFamilyIncomeUpdate.exe.

The installer displays the **Welcome** screen:



2. Click the **Next** button.

The installer displays the **Database Server Login** screen:




- 3. Do one of the following:
  - In the Database server that you are installing to field, enter the SQL Server name and instance to which you are installing the data.

Example: SVRBOS01\SQLEXPRESS


- Click the **Browse** button and in the resultant dialog box, select the SQL Server.
- 4. Choose one of the following authentication options:
  - Use Windows Authentication
  - Use SQL Server Authentication If you select this option, you must also enter your SQL
    Server account User Name and Password in the User Name and Password fields.
- 5. Click the **Next** button.

The software displays the **Ready to Install** screen:


6. In the **Ready to Install the Program** screen, click the **Install** button to start the installation:

When installation is complete, the installer displays the **Finish** screen:




7. Click the **Finish** button to exit.


# **3** Confirming Installation

To confirm installation of the data, in CRA Wiz and Fair Lending Wiz, do the following:


- 1. Navigate to Analysis -> Create Areas.
- 2. Select the **Anniston-Oxford AL MSA**, right-click on the area, and from the contextual menu select **Show Demographics**:




The software displays the **Demographic Information** pane:




3. Select 2023 from the Year drop-down menu:

4. Weighted Average of MSA/Non-MSA's Updated Median Family Income should match the screenshot below:
