1 Overview

This update provides the latest business demographic data for use in performance context analysis of small business lending.

1.1 Data Source

1.2 Who Should Install

Any client licensed for Business Demographic Data should install this update. To determine if you are licensed for Business Demographic Data, go to the **System Maintenance** screen and select **License and Access Management**.

1.3 Prerequisites

CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* 7.4 is required to install this update. To check your CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* version, go to the program menu bar and select **Help > About CRA *Wiz***. Build numbers starting with "74" are acceptable.

1.4 Required permissions

This update is installed as a single table on your SQL server, so both Windows read/write permissions and SQL Server table creation permissions are required. Wolters Kluwer Financial Services recommends that the user running the install have both Windows admin and SQL Server admin login credentials.

1.5 Required free space

Approximately 50MB (megabytes).

1.6 Approximate install time

Less than 15 minutes.

2 Installation Instructions

To install 2020 Business Demographic Data, follow these steps:

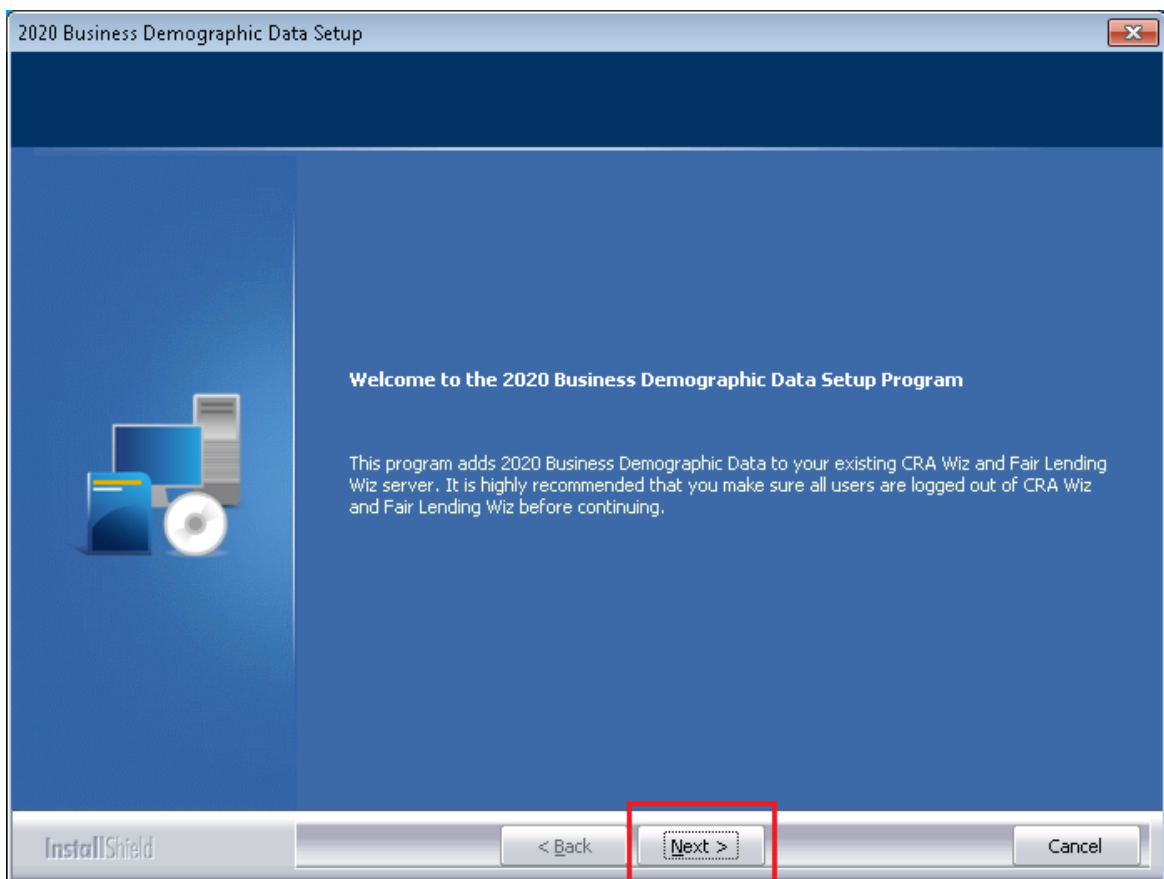
1. After downloading the update locally to your SQL Server, locate and double-click the **2020BusinessDemographicData** installation file.

The installer displays the **Welcome** screen.

2. Follow the directions for each of the following screens.

2.1 Welcome Screen

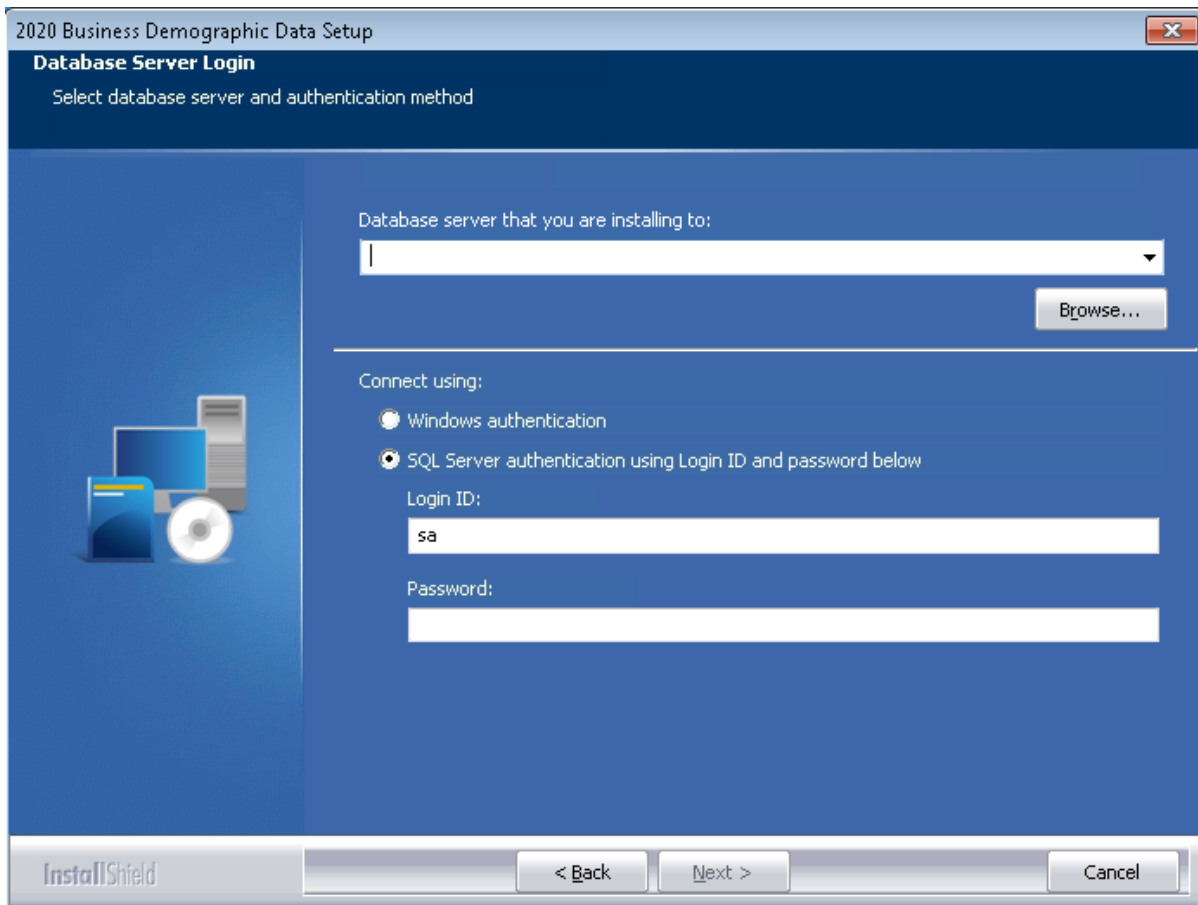
Click the **Next** button:



The software displays the **SQL Server Login** screen.

2.2 SQL Server Login Screen

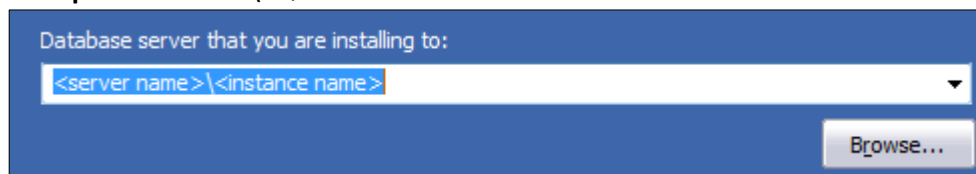
Use this screen to enter the name of the **SQL Server** and to configure authentication options:



Note: The software displays the Database Server Login screen only if the computer on which you are installing the update is running **SQL Server**. If the installer does not detect SQL Server on your computer, the installer displays the screen.


1. In the **Database server that you are installing to:** field, enter the **SQL Server name and instance** to which you are installing the data as shown below:

Example: SVRBOS01\SQLEXPRESS



2. Choose one of the following authentication options:

- Windows Authentication
- SQL Server Authentication using Login ID and password below - If you select this option, you must also enter your SQL Server account Login ID (user name) and Password in the **Login ID** and **Password** fields.

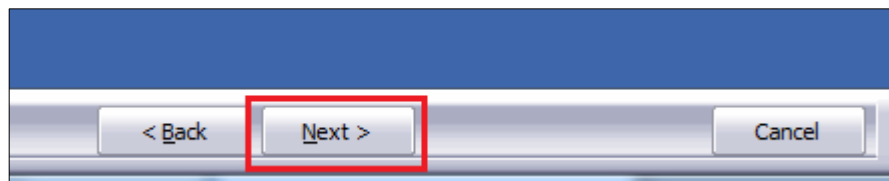

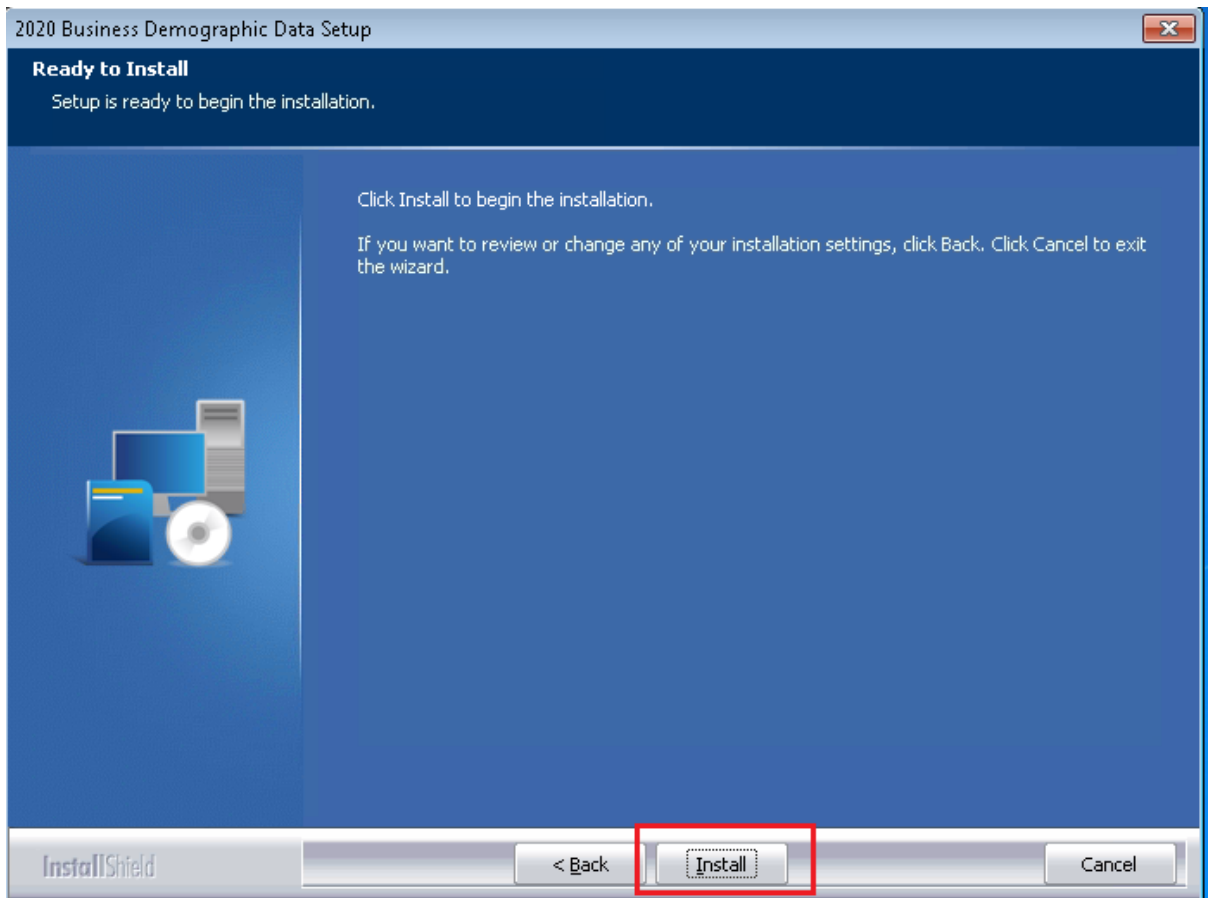
3. Click the **Next** button:

2.3 Ready to Install Screen

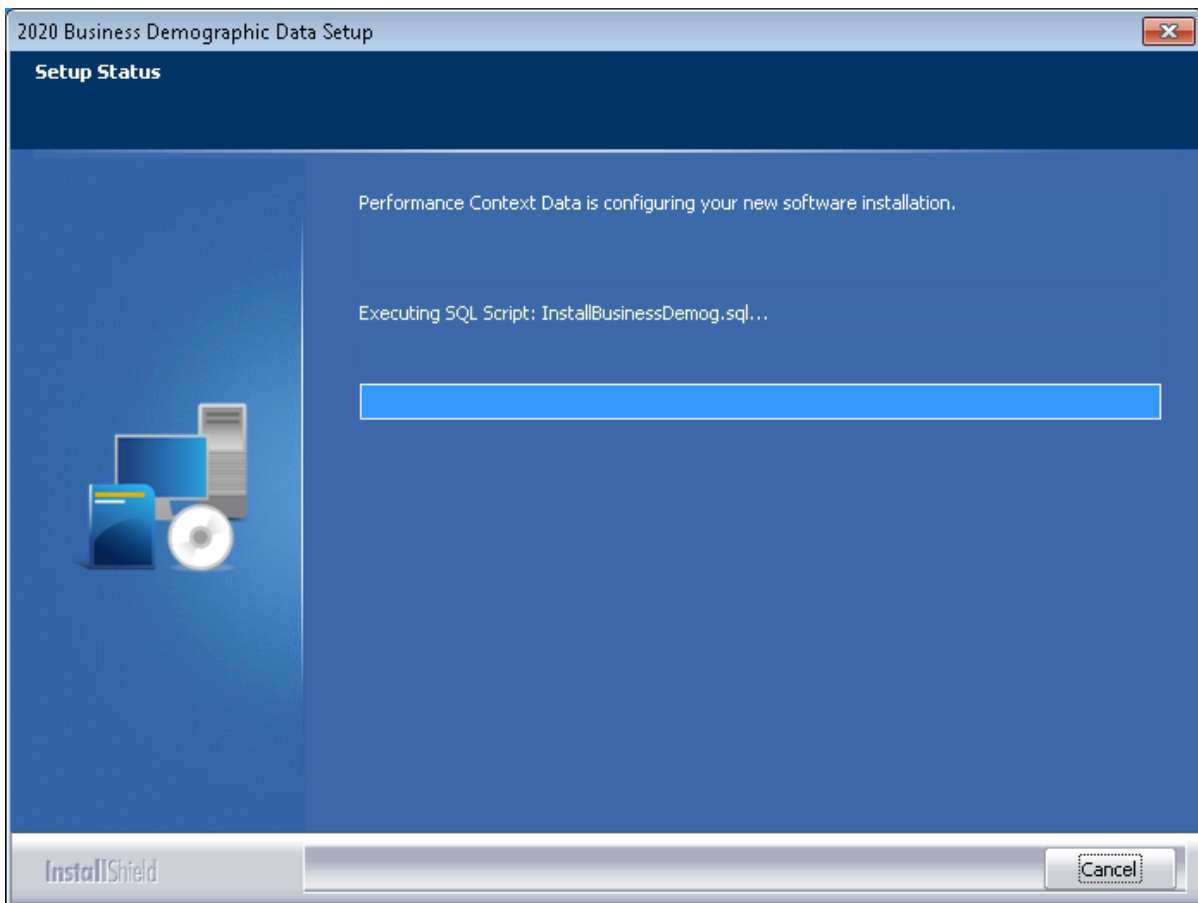
To begin installing the data sets, click the **Install** button:

3 Confirming Installation

Once the installation is complete, you can verify the installation by selecting the **Create Areas** option in the CRA *Wiz* and Fair Lending *Wiz* sidebar. You will also need to set Census boundaries to **2010**, located in the **Options** menu bar item.

In **Create Areas**, right-click on a demographic area and choose **Show Demographics**. Then choose **2020** from the dropdown (1) and you will see Business Demographics in the lower left corner:
